Rules of the Competition

1. The Open challenge is open to men, ladies, juniors and junior juniors
2. Adults aged 18 years and over as at January 1st 2017
3. Youth section aged under 18 as at 1st January 2017
4. Junior section aged under 11 as at January 1st 2017.
5. The competitions to be played over 6 holes on the Short Course.
6. 6 hole stroke play competition. The entry fee adult £15. And junior £10 per person will include 6 holes of golf, nearest the pin, beat the Pro, and a 1 course chef special
7. Prizes will be allocated to 1st, 2nd & 3rd in the adult section and junior section
8. Tee times available all day
9. All ties will be decided on a card play-off.
10. It is not necessary for a competitor to have been allocated an official CONGU or club playing handicap. The handicap will be divided by 3
11. Should it become necessary to restrict the number of competitors, entrants will be accepted strictly according to their date of entry.
12. No entries will be accepted by telephone or after the closing date for entries.
13. No refunds will be granted inside 48 hours of the event.
14. The Director of Golf reserves the right to refuse any entry without explanation and to adjust the playing handicap of any intending competitors.
15. All disputes shall be decided by the Director of Golf appointed for the purpose of this competition whose decision shall be final.
16. When play is suspended for a dangerous situation (e.g. lightning) the signal will be a prolonged blast on a klaxon.
13. If you suffer from a condition which may require urgent medical attention (e.g. Asthma, diabetes, epilepsy, heart condition, allergies to bee or wasp stings, etc.), it is important to notify an official on the day of the competition.
14. **Caddies (including parents) will be allowed.**
15. Local competition rules will be published and distributed for each individual event. *These rules may not conform to the Rules of Golf as laid down by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and shall be used for the specific event only.*
